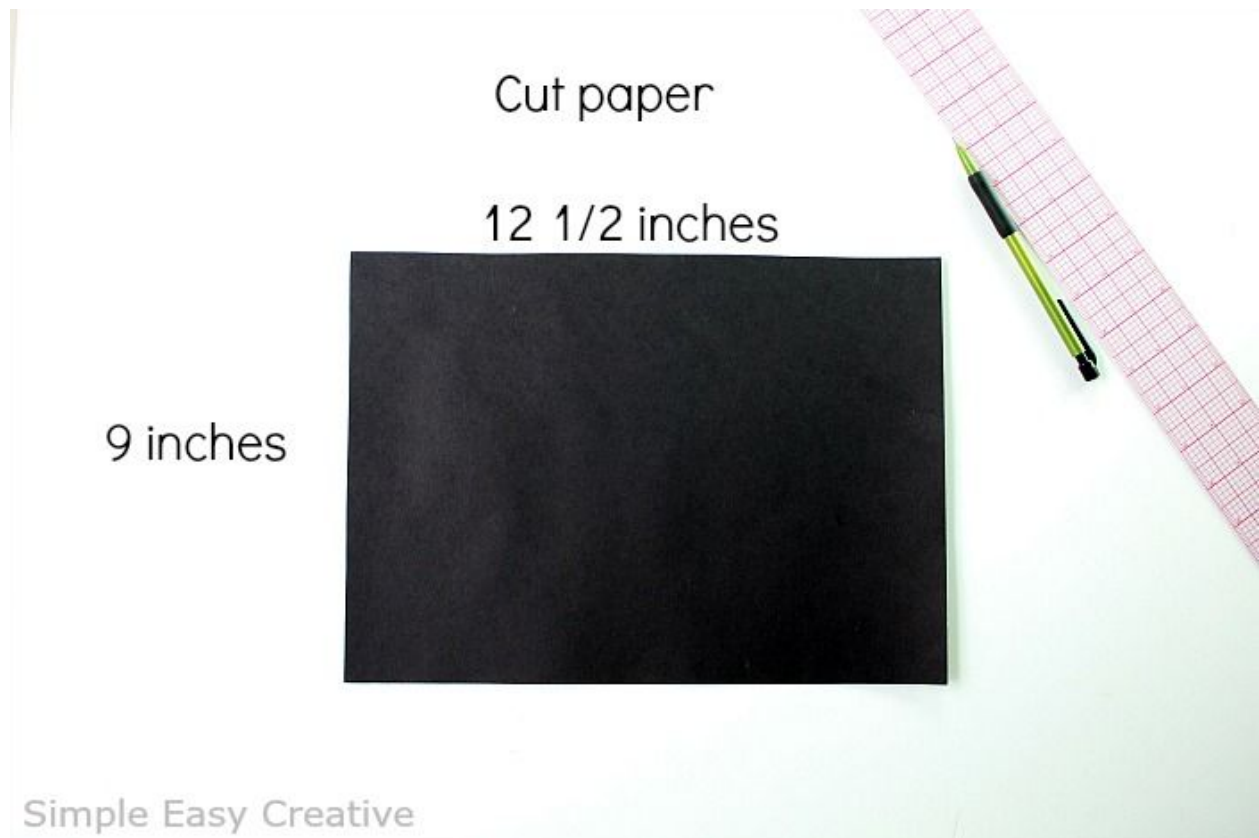
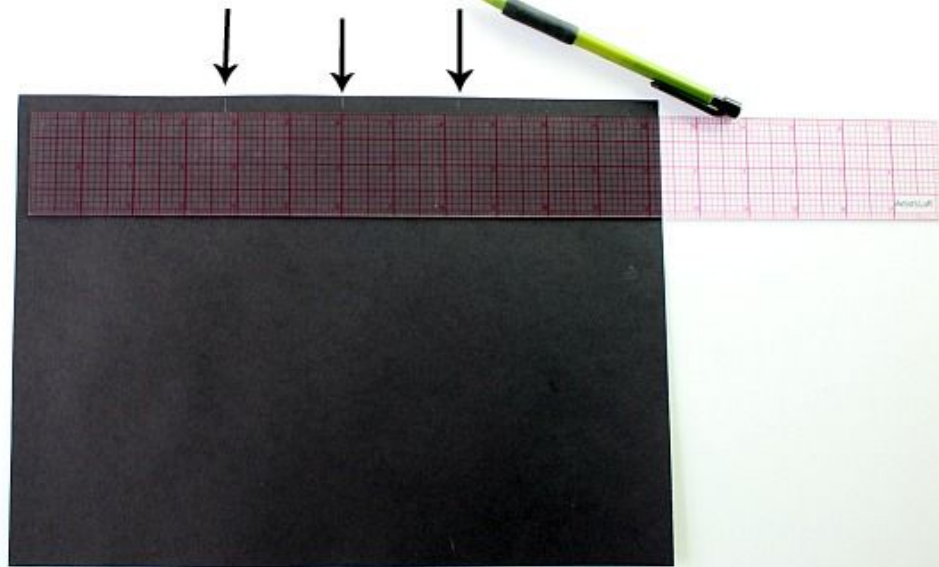

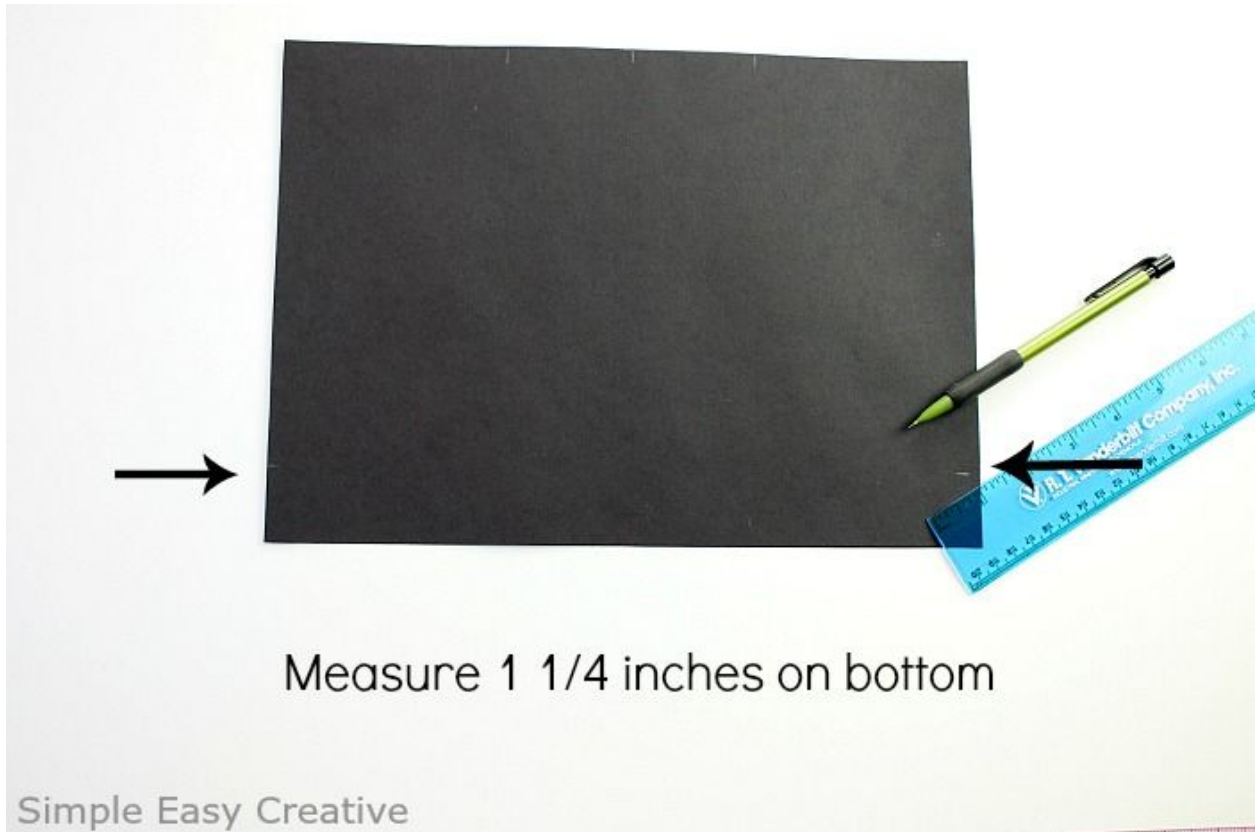
Cut black paper - 12 1/2 x 9 inches

Measure and mark
6 1/4 inches (center)
2 1/4 inches to left and right of center

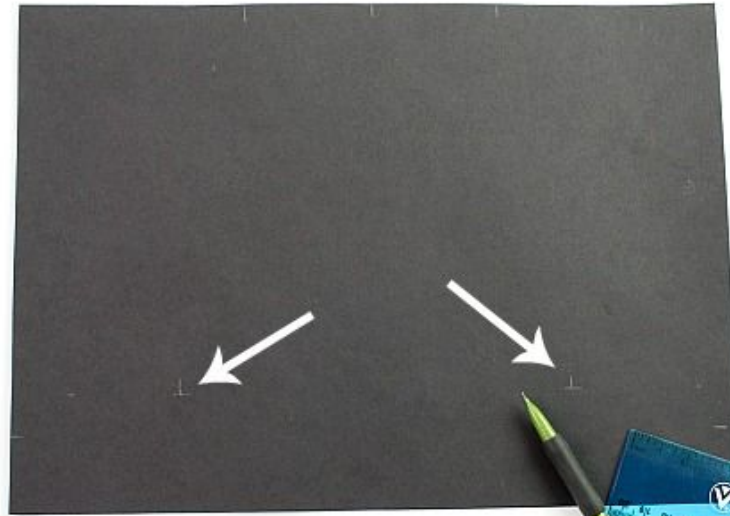


Simple Easy Creative

At the top - mark 6 1/4 inches (this is center) - then mark 2 1/4 inches to the left and to the right of that mark. This will create 4 1/2 inches at the top of the hat



On the bottom - measure 1 1/4 inches on each side of paper



Measure in $2 \frac{3}{4}$ inches from each side
Measure 2 inches from bottom

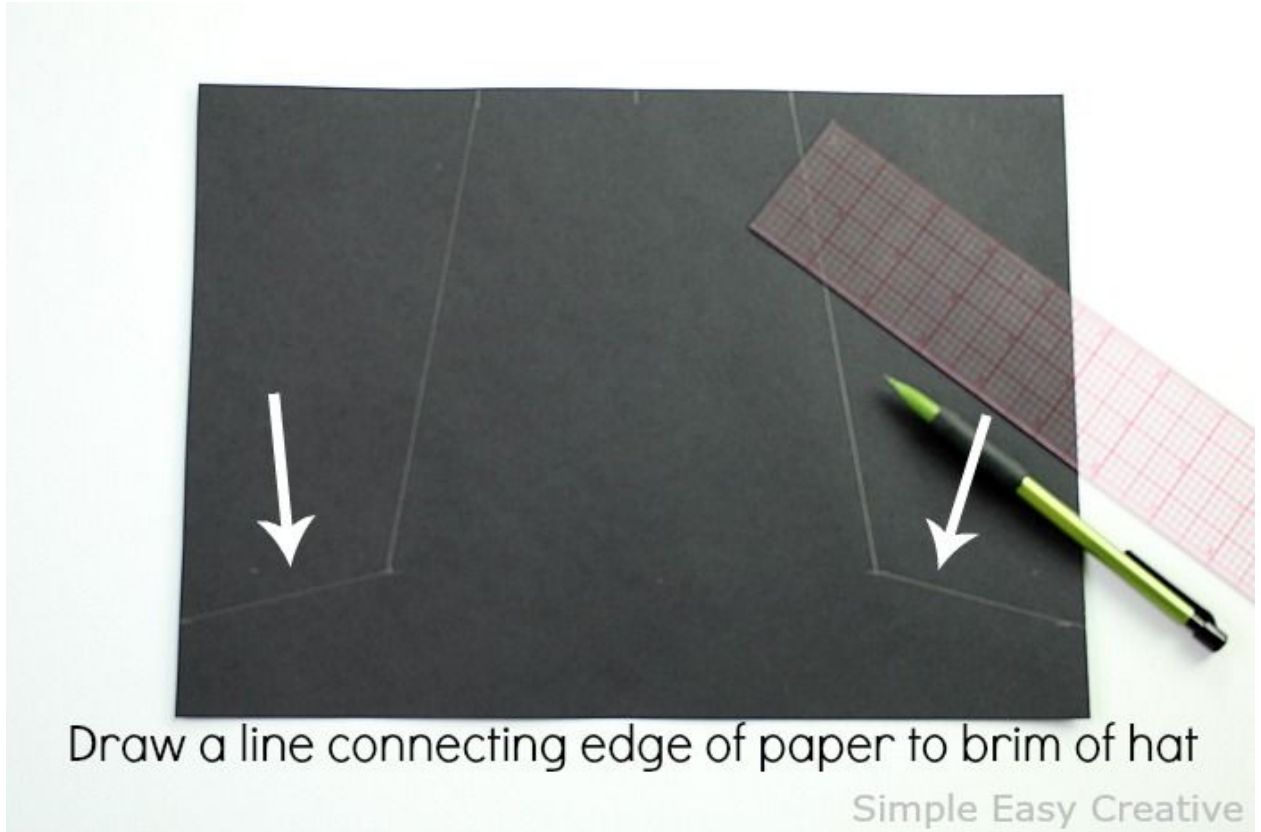

Measure in $2 \frac{3}{4}$ inches from each side. Measure 2 inches from bottom



Draw a line connecting top
mark + bottom mark

Draw a line connecting the top mark to the bottom mark
(the last one you made)



Draw a line connecting the edge of the paper to brim of hat



Cut out hat

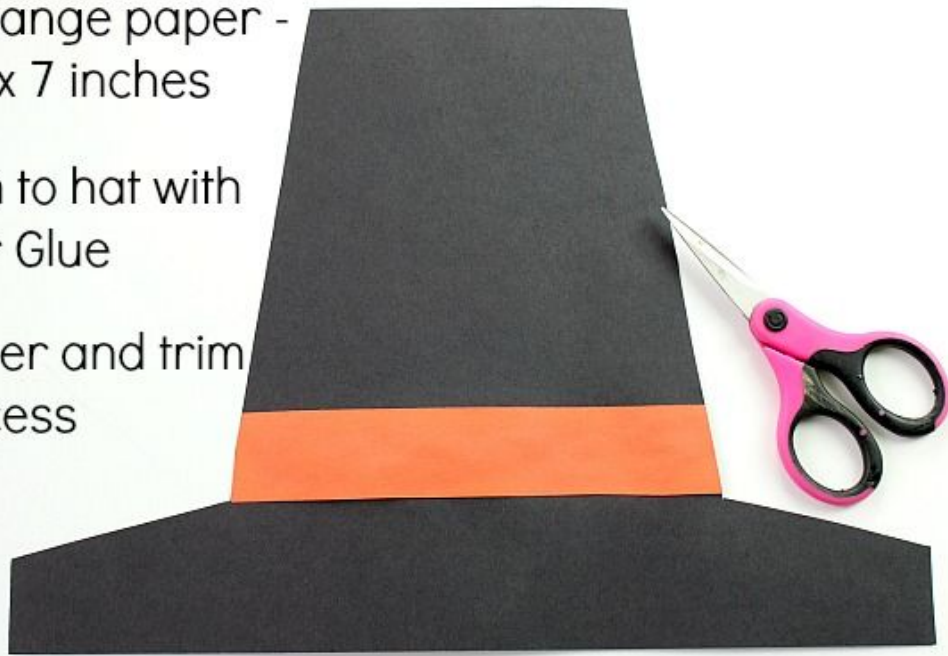

Cut out hat

Cut orange paper -
1 1/4 x 7 inches

Attach to hat with
Sugar Glue

Flip over and trim
off excess



Simple Easy Creative

Cut out orange paper - 1 1/4 x 7 inches. Attach with Sugar Glue. Flip hat over and trim off excess orange band.



Cut yellow paper - 2 1/2 inch square



Mark center of square. Mark 1 inch square in the center



Cut out center of buckle

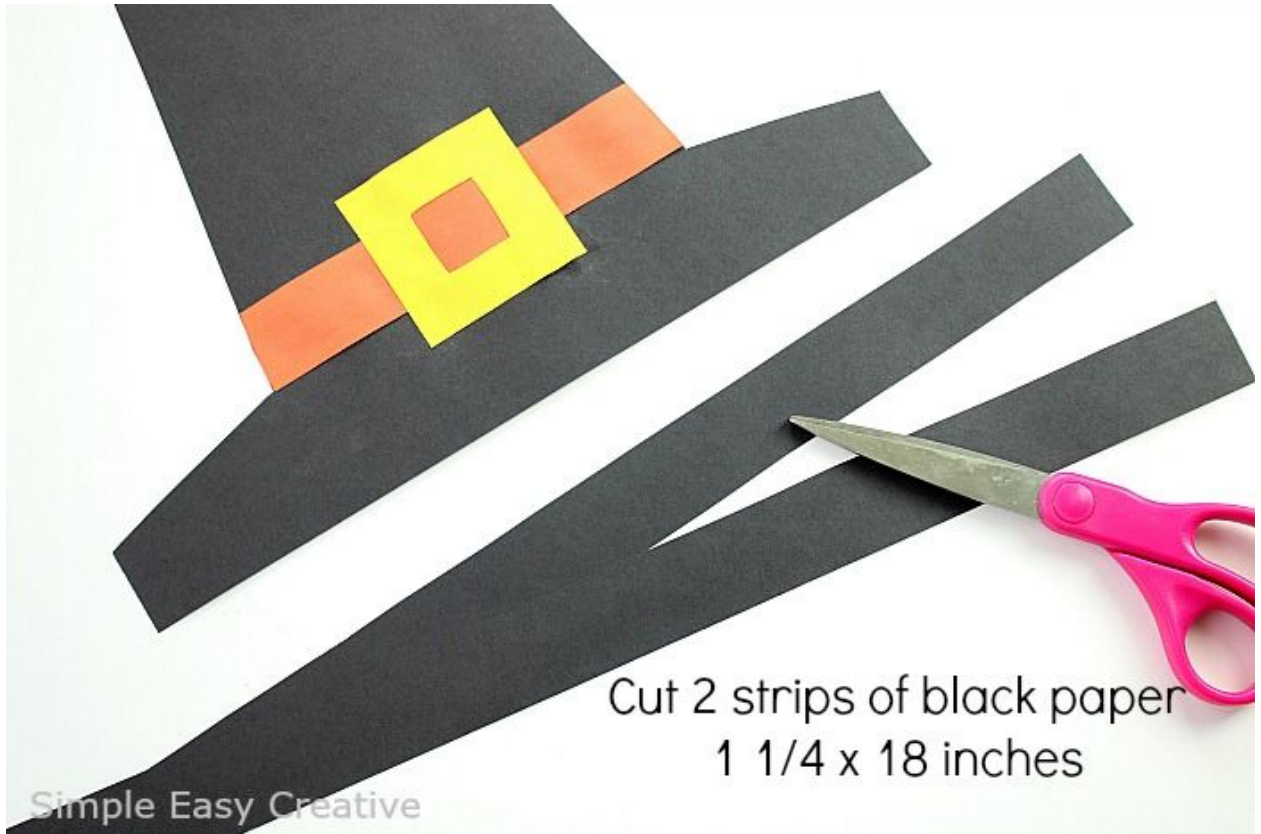
Cut out center of buckle



Simple Easy Creative

Attach buckle onto hat with Sugar Glue

Attach buckle onto hat with Sugar Glue



Cut 2 strips of black paper - 1 1/4 x 18 inches



Attach strips to back of hat
with Sugar Glue

Simple Easy Creative

Flip hat over and attach strips with Sugar Glue to center of hat. NOTE - at this point you can glue the strips completely down all the way across the bottom of the hat, or leave part of the strip unattached - this way the hat will set straight and not wrap around the head
